STUDENTS' RESPONSIBILITIES

It is the responsibility of all students registering in the Faculty of Arts:

1. to become familiar with the specific requirements for their degree and with the academic regulations;
2. to ensure that the chosen courses meet all the programme requirements and the requirements for graduation;
3. to ensure that they have completed the prerequisite(s) for the courses chosen;
4. to ensure that there are no scheduling conflicts for the courses they have chosen;
5. to meet all the deadlines indicated in the University Calendar

SCHEDULING REQUIREMENTS

Students must plan their schedules with care to ensure proper progress through the programme.

AND keep in mind that **required courses may *not* be offered** every year in their preferred language. Plan accordingly.

****SRS4202 & SRS4302****

SRS4202 is a required course for Major and Honours students. Each year it is offered in either French OR English (not both!). If it offered in English this year, it will be offered in French next year. Plan accordingly.

Why wait for your 4th year? MAJOR students: Don't hesitate to take **SRS4202** (Methods and Theories in the Study of Religion) in your 3rd year. HONOURS students: Don't hesitate to take **SRS4202** and/or **SRS4302** in your 3rd year.

NOTES ON PREREQUISITES

There are no formal prerequisites for any course in the BA programme of Religious Studies. Nevertheless, students are strongly encouraged to begin with 1000 and 2000 level courses before progressing to the more advanced level courses.

SCHOLARSHIPS

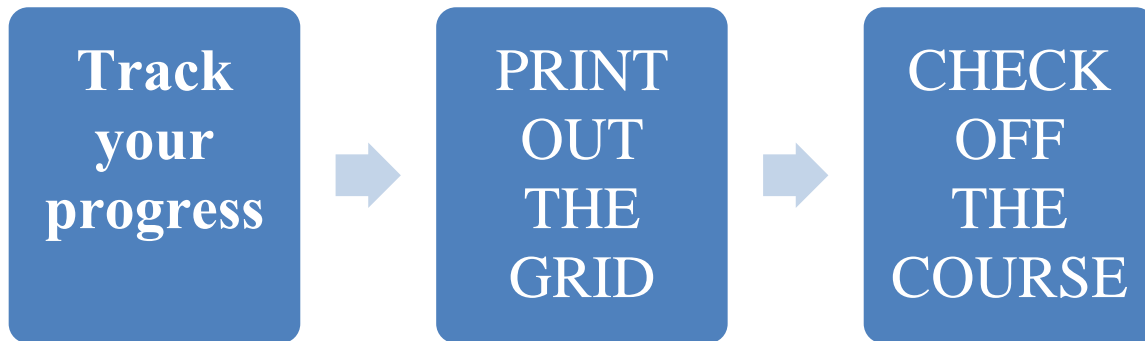
The University of Ottawa offers many scholarships to students at the BA level. A "Directory of Undergraduate Awards" is available at Financial Aids Services, located in the University Centre.
